
Our camp program runs Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 4:00

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Campers participate in two riding lessons a day with our coaches & instructors. Our coaches group campers accordingly to their age and experience level. Lessons will allow beginner riders to develop introductory walk and trot skills. Riders with experience will work towards advancing and improving their riding skillset. In addition, the horsemanship activities and stable management will create a strong foundation for students on safety around horses, grooming techniques, general horse care and equipment.

Our priority at Belle Wood is the safety and welfare of students and horses. Therefore, campers will be placed in appropriate groups by our Camp Director after Monday's assessment lesson or moved into another group unless our Camp Director feels it is suitable and the students will prosper further in their development.

Cancelled sessions eight days or more before the camp session start date will be charged a \$300.00+hst cancellation fee. Sessions cancelled seven days or less before the camp session's start date or once camp has commenced are non-refundable. NO EXCEPTIONS.

For the safety and welfare of both students and horses, lessons will not commence in temperatures exceeding 25 Degrees or when a weather warning is in place.

What does your camper need to bring??

- Properly fitted ASTM-approved for equestrian use riding helmet.
- Boots to ride, with a heel no more than 1/4 inch
- Riding pants, Leggings, and Jeans are suitable for riding. No baggy sweatpants, as they can be a safety hazard and could get caught on equipment.
- Riding gloves to protect hands from leather reins
- Running shoes for games & shorts
- Bathing suit
- Sunscreen, bug spray, hat
- Fresh spring water is available in a refillable water bottle.
- We ask campers to do their best to bring a "Litter-less" Lunch.
